Multi Agency Training

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Outline

The TSCB is committed to promoting the training and development of staff who are working with children and vulnerable families. The TSCB supports the view that a combination of single and multi-agency training underpins best practice in early support and safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and that this can help achieve better outcomes for vulnerable families.

Description

Level 2 - Core Multi-Agency Safeguarding Children Courses

Target Audience - Staff who may be required to undertake or contribute to an Early Health Assessment or other assessment, or who provide interventions to support children or parents.

- Using the Early Help Assessment and the Role of Case Co-ordinator - 1 day
- Promoting Children and Young People's Participation - ½ day
- The Voice of the Child - ½ day
- Awareness of Prevent - ½ day

Level 3 - Specialist Multi-Agency Safeguarding Children courses

Target Audience - Staff with a substantial degree of responsibility to safeguard children through assessment and intervention. Those who work extensively in a multi-agency context.

- Safeguarding Disabled Children Multi-Agency course - 1 day
- Safeguarding Children in Care Multi-Agency course - 1 day
- Safeguarding Children and Young People from Sexual Exploitation - 1 day
- Effective Participation in Multi-Agency Safeguarding Children Meetings - 1 day
- Safeguarding Children from Neglect and Emotional Abuse - 1 day

- Children and Domestic Abuse - 1 day
- Parental Difficulties and their Impact on Children - 1 day
- Parent Abuse by Adolescent Children - ½ day
- Safeguarding Children from FGM - ½ day

Outcome

Individual professionals should identify their training needs and which courses are appropriate to them with their manager, based on their job roles and contact with children and young people. Each level of training gives an indication of their target audiences. Training is also only effective if it impacts on people's practice – so we ask all participants and their managers on TSCB multi agency courses to take responsibility for ensuring that they reflect on the learning from courses and implement any changes in their practice.

Audience

All partners who work with children, including local authorities, the police, the health service, the courts, professionals, the voluntary sector and individual members of local communities

Booking Information
